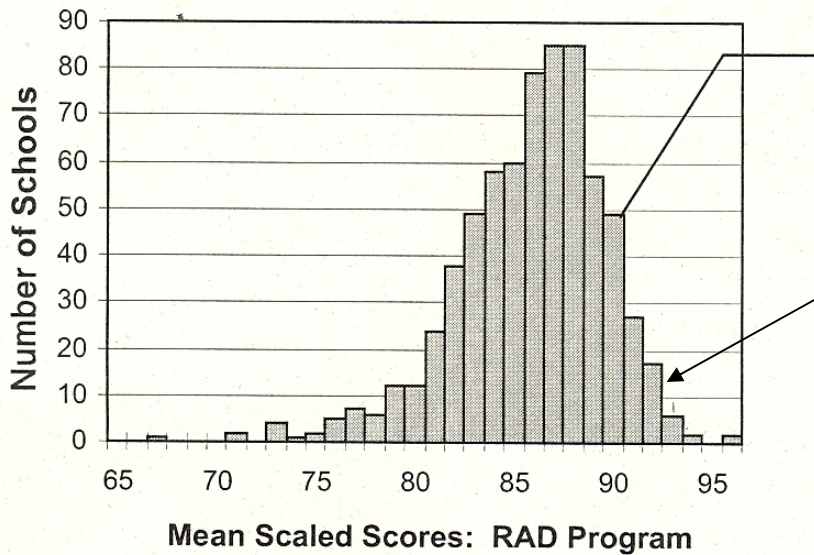

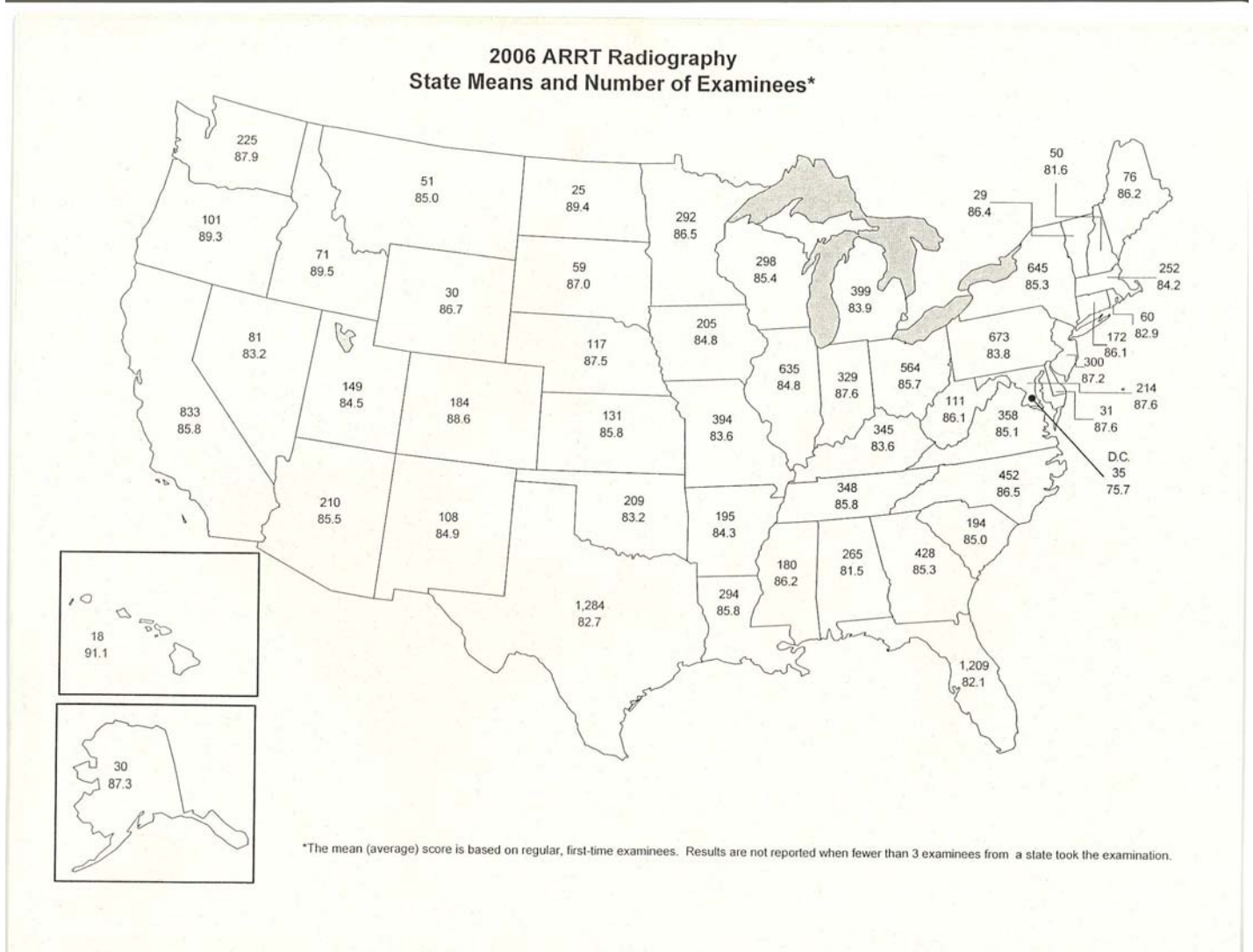
***BSU had results in the top 2% of the nation related to other radiography programs.**

These results assisted Idaho to be ranked 2nd as a state based on mean test score (89.5 with 71 examinees), with only Hawaii possessing a better state average (91.1 with 18 examinees).
