2005 Student Selection Criteria

Boise State University has a 3-year associate degree program in Radiologic Sciences with a competitive application process. The student capacity per year is 24 individuals.

Initial Criteria:

- a. completion of the 34 credits of required prerequisite courses (or equivalent) by the end of the spring semester of the application year. (Students must be registered for these courses at the time of application)
- b. a minimum of 2.60 GPA for the 31 credits of the required prerequisite courses. (Core elective must be completed but not utilized in GPA compilation) Grades are to be based on at least 15 credits of prerequisite courses. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.40.
- c. completion of a program application by February 15 of the application year, to include a current transcript, letter of application and three references.

For the 2005 application process, 97 completed applications were received. Nineteen (19) of the applicants had applied before (reapplicant). There were 24 male and 73 female applicants.

Secondary Criteria:

The applicants were selected for an interview based on prerequisite GPA, letter of application analysis and reference analysis. The top 67 individuals were invited for an interview. Twenty-one males and 46 females were interviewed.

A total of twenty-two applicants were placed on the alternate list. Interviewed applicants were currently attending the following educational institutions/states: Wyoming (1), NIC (1), Utah (1), California (1), ISU (3), CSI (1), BYU-I (1), Oregon (2), BSU (56). Eight interviewed students had a completed baccalaureate degree, four had prior associate degrees. Additional applicants not interviewed were from ISU(3), BYU-Idaho (1), Oregon (2), NNU (1), TVCC (1) and BSU (22).
